# Monitoring and Feedback (GRI 2-12, 2-26)

# Projects with UNICEF and Akelius (GRI 2-6, 2-29)

As part of the collaboration with UNICEF and the Akelius Foundation, the SDG Integration Center (SDGIC) implemented projects aimed at language integration, inclusivity, and the digital transformation of education. Three training sessions on blended learning were organized, involving over 90 educators. The methodological guidelines developed include station rotation, flipped classroom models, and the use of AI tools for language learning.

Participation in the project provides students and educators with access to international expertise and digital tools, enhances teaching practices, and fosters the development of 21st-century skills.





# Case Championship

## "Eco Solutions IITU" (GRI 3-3)

Eco Solutions IITU is a flagship student event within the university's sustainability agenda. From June 2 to 5, 2025, nine teams presented practical environmental solutions that could be integrated into the university's infrastructure. The championship was organized in collaboration with the Civil Alliance of Almaty and the UNICEF Innovation Lab. The jury included representatives from NGOs, IITU, and the academic community.

Projects were evaluated based on five criteria: implementation, applicability, innovation, presentation, and user-friendliness. The winners were: 1st place – Eco-three, 2nd place – GreenBite, 3rd place – Green Light. All participants received certificates and gifts from the university. Additionally, members of the GreenBite team were invited by the Director of the Milestone Foundation to join a social IT project.
